How P.G.I. Works

Request a Passport from your district director of personal growth or call the International Office at 1-800-500-8130, extension 242. Your district director of personal growth serves as the administrator of the program in your district.

- Use your passport to record the completion of requirements for each level. All activities at each level through level seven must be attested to by your club secretary-treasurer or president in the passport. Levels eight, nine and ten must be attested to by your lieutenant governor or governor.
- As you complete levels one through seven have your passport signed by the club secretary-treasurer or president, and for levels eight, nine and ten have your passport signed by the lieutenant governor or governor, who should forward the P.G.I. Recognition Form to the district director of personal growth.
- Round colored tabs (which fit behind your lapel pin) representing the level attained will be distributed upon completion of each of the first seven levels along with a Presidential Certificate of Personal Growth will be given to each member upon completion of the seventh (gold) level.
- A lapel pin will be presented at a district meeting (where possible) and will be recognized at the International Convention by the International President upon completion of Level ten. Tabs are sent to the club from the district director of personal growth upon receipt of the P.G.I. Recognition Form.

PERSONAL GROWTH AND INVOLVEMENT PROGRAM INSTRUCTIONS

The following instructions are only meant to be suggestions and it is not mandatory that you follow these procedures. PGI Achievements are now listed on the Club Rosters.

When a member enrolls in the PGI Program they receive a Passport and enters his/her name, club name and club number on the front.

As a member completes a step the club director of personal growth, club president or secretary-treasurer initials beside the step completed on the passport, initiates a Club PGI Tracking Form and enters the date each level is completed on the form.

When an entire level is completed, the club director of personal growth, club president or secretary-treasurer signs and dates the bottom of the page of the level completed on the passport. The club then forwards a copy of the PGI Recognition Form to the District Director of Personal Growth for processing.

The District Director of Personal Growth submits the name, club number, member number and date completed to the Leadership Development Department at Optimist International.

Optimist International will forward to the District Director of Personal Growth the appropriate pin backings and certificate for level VII to be presented to the member(s) at the next district conference/convention.

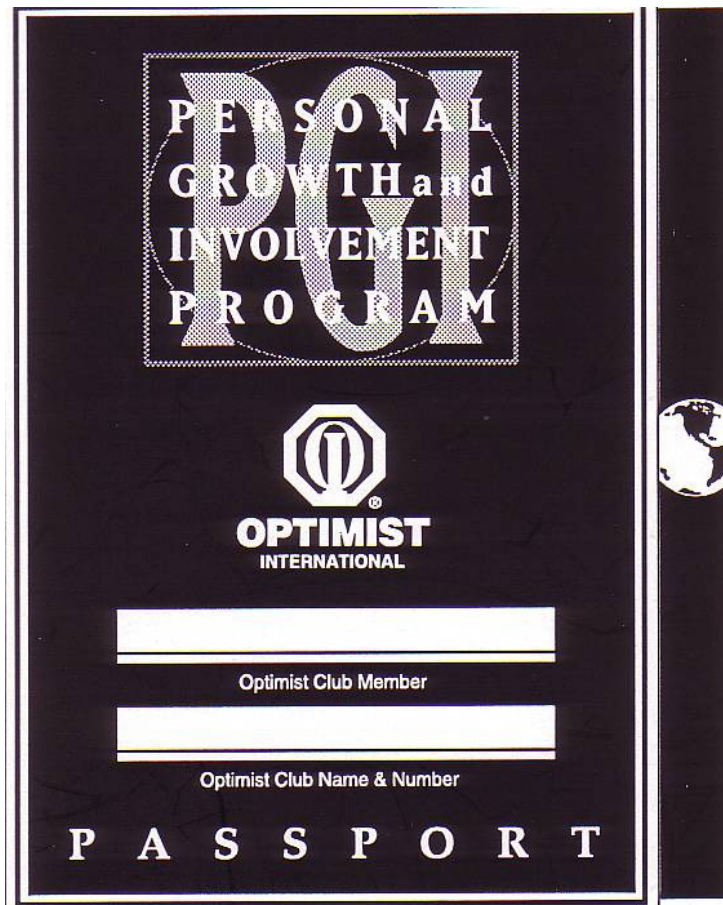

HOW CAN YOU USE P.G.I. SUCCESSFULLY AS CLUB PRESIDENT?

- 1. Consider every element of P.G.I. as equally important in developing true leadership of your members.**
- 2. Explain P.G.I. at your first meeting and stress the importance it will have during your year.**
- 3. Display a progress chart at every meeting to help promote the progress made by every member.**
- 4. Every month recognize achievers by presenting the colored tabs in a special way. The recipient should be seated at the head table and the colored tabs should be presented by the lieutenant governor, the mayor or the club president.**
- 5. Introduce all new members to P.G.I. as soon as they join your Club.**
- 6. Appoint a Club Director of Personal Growth to track each member's progress and to reflect that progress on a progress chart.**
- 7. When there are public speaking presentations and opportunities, diversify the subjects to include talks about your Club, the organization, the benefits of belonging to an Optimist Club or something personal. Your goal is to give every member a chance to speak in front of his/her peers.**
- 8. Invite everyone who has achieved a new level to attend the district conference so he/she can be acknowledged by the district governor.**
- 9. Promote the Optimist Skills Development Modules available at www.optimistleaders.org.**
- 10. Make sure you are the first one to "lead by example."**
- 11. Challenge the member who achieves the most levels during your year to become the "Optimist of the Year" in your Club.**
- 12. Make sure you submit achievers to the District Director of Personal Growth by completing the appropriate form and present the awards to every member who achieves a new level.**

Attend three training seminars at a district convention or three Back-To-School Workshops at the International Convention.

COMMUNICATION:

Assist a member in achieving Level VII of PGI.

CERTIFICATION:

Activities to be certified by the lieutenant governor or governor.
